Second Saturday ArtWalk is where the Central Arts District, Grand Central District, Warehouse Arts District, Uptown Arts District and downtown Waterfront District come together as ONE ARTS DESTINATION with many venues hosting the opening night of their latest exhibit. ArtWalk takes place every Second Saturday of the month and these venues are happily waiting for your exploration, conversation, purchases and inspiration! Make an evening of it and stop for dinner, drinks or dessert at a local restaurant.

A branded white trolley with will also be moving art enthusiasts around to over 40 ArtWalk venues from 5-9pm. (The Waterfront District galleries can be seen by using the FREE Downtown Looper, which runs every 15 minutes.) The trolley will start at 5pm, than make continuous loops until 9pm.

Keep in mind that there is only one trolley running at this time, so wait times between stops may be up to 1 hour, which gives you plenty of time to relax, explore and support our artists through a purchase! Stop by to see a working studio space in the ArtsXchange where they create large-scale public artworks for local and national collections.

But they will wait for ARTWALK and hold their heads up high and they'll never walk alone.

- The story of the devastating loss of Águeda Sanfiz's sister at the beginning of 2020 is thoughtfully and gently conveyed to us in her exhibition. Águeda Sanfiz: The Other Pandemic serves a dual purpose: to stand as a historic record of what life was like for many during this unprecedented time, and to bring awareness to the often-taboo subject of death by suicide. Heavy subjects, certainly, and Sanfiz handles the aftermath with a keen, unflinching eye. Yet each frame is imbued with love and tenderness, drawing us, the viewers, into her story of how to celebrate a life even while mourning its loss during epic times, even separated by continents and oceans. As Sanfiz reminds us in her artist statement: "You felt alone, but you were not alone."
- Tom Kramer was a beloved local dance, film, and theater photographer. What Tom's admirers might not know is that he was a regular at the Morean Arts Center's Saturday Open Figure Drawing Studio for nearly 20 years, an artistic passion which honed his understanding of human anatomy and informed his photography. Tom passed away in 2022 at the age of 87, unfortunately before this exhibition came to fruition. His last series of photographs was created at the Palladium Theater in downtown St. Petersburg with a handful of dancers and lighting technicians over a period of four days. Tom Kramer: Forever Changed addresses the lack of connectivity felt during COVID, which hit the arts community particularly hard. In Tom's own words, "A good dance photograph has to be both a good photograph and good dance. It's a totally collaborative process...you do it on those rare occasions when the dancers have a stage and the lights are on."
- Wonder in the Wild: Photographic Works by Curtis Anderson Jr. + Stefan Jennings Batista is a visual pursuit of the spiritual enigma that has invaded the human experience told from two different perspectives. Curtis Anderson Jr. is a Sarasota-based Art Director/ Portrait Photographer from Columbus, Ohio. Curtis' photographs reflect what the Gospel of Jesus is and often what it is not from the perspective of a black man living in the south. He accomplishes this by reflecting on the "as is" moments in life while trying to frame a narrative around the





subject. Stefan Jennings Batista is a visual artist, educator and designer based in Albuquerque, New Mexico. His mainly photographic
