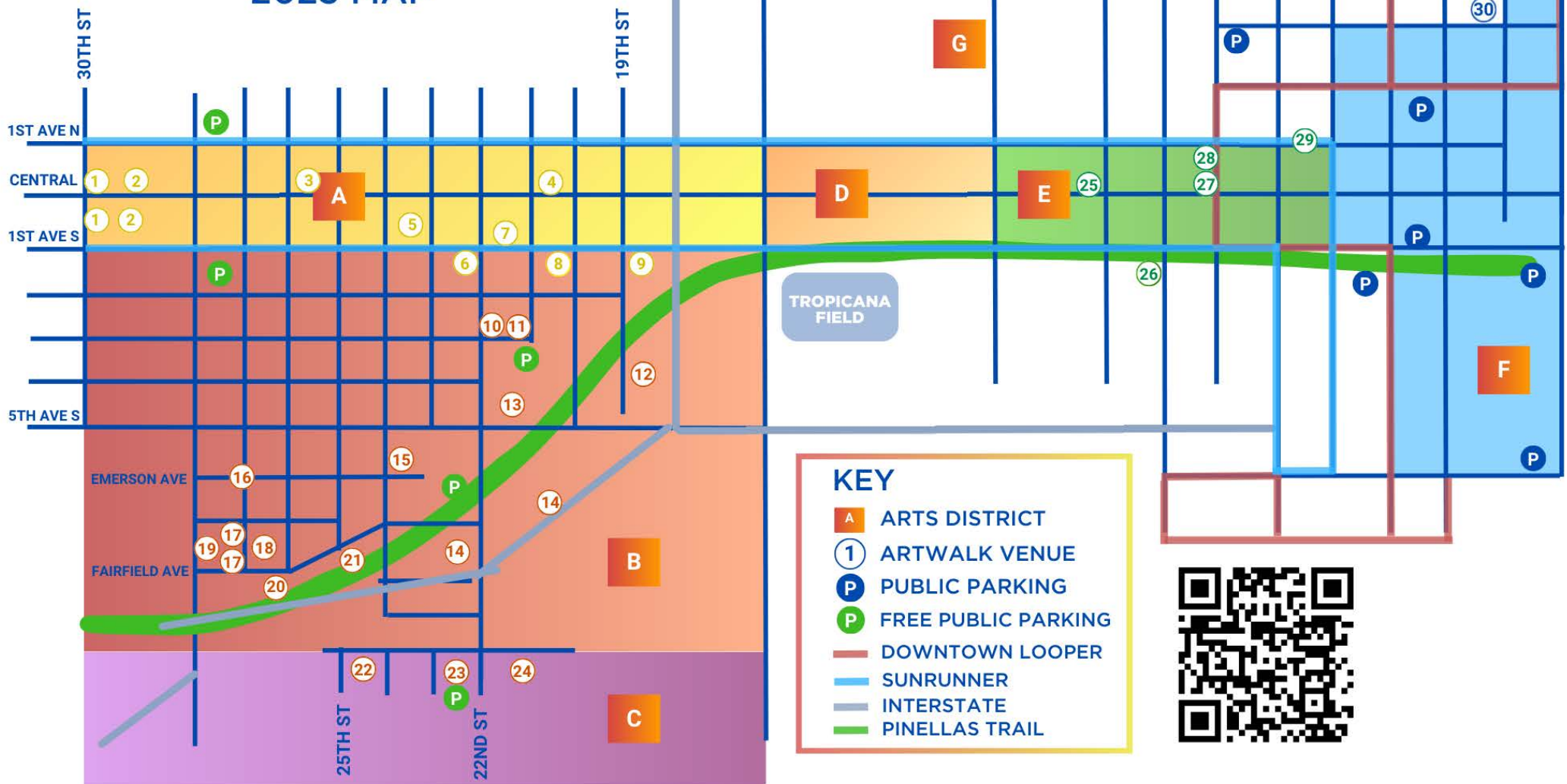

Also on view will be a video delving into her Mayan heritage and artistic process as well as a mock studio where gallery guests will be able to see her backstrap loom and materials, and where she will lead a workshop for those interested in learning the Pikb'il tradition. In our Gabinetto Segreto, two mural-sized paintings by Tampa artist Carlos Pons Paz will engulf the small 90 square foot space, creating an axis mundi for contemplation of the cycles of life and personal transformation. Also on view will be several of his small sculptures made of fabric and clay, suggestive of votive figurines, and two of his newest paintings that "carry the clarity, focus, and intention that come with" his own transformation from emerging artist to working artist.
