where he graduated with a bachelor of fine arts degree in 2005. He is recognized for his figurative paintings that explore the cultivation of community and vulnerability, and the resulting social dislocation of broken homes and marginalized neighborhoods." Vasquez cites his experience growing up without a father figure, and without siblings, as a source of inspiration for the work, and attributes this to notions of an extended family where a sense (or illusion) of identity may exist.

Using his own photographs of friends and familiar environments as source material, Vasquez configures subjects into powerful, often larger-than-life compositions. He includes visual cues that infer identity, such as color, hand signs, symbols and
