Things to Know to Receive a SHINE Mural:

As a leading arts destination throughout the country, SHINE St. Petersburg Mural Festival will showcase the City of the Arts with vibrant, creative and inspiring murals in public spaces. For 10-days each October, SHINE will spotlight St. Petersburg with a curated, open-air museum showcasing local and international mural artists.

- The SHINE committee will assign a local or international artist to your wall. You will see previous examples of the artist's work. Mural renderings are NOT required.
- To ensure the best outcomes, artists are given creative freedom. SHINE murals cannot be construed as direct advertising for a business.
- The artwork must remain on the wall for one year.
- Wall submissions do not guarantee involvement in the festival and will be kept on file for future consideration.
- The St. Petersburg Arts Alliance will carry appropriate volunteer insurance, and artists and assistants will sign Hold Harmless agreements.
- A donation of \$1,000 is required to cover the artist's payment.
- **Deadline to apply: July 1, 2019.**
